- Visiting Researcher:
Position 1 - General field and/or branch in which the candidate should be specialised: Sociology, Sociology of health and medicine, Social and health evaluation and communication in complex systems.

WHO is eligible?

Qualified academic staff from any country (except Romania), who holds a PhD and a higher education teaching / research institutional affiliation

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Grant Period:

- 2 positions of Visiting Lecturers: 1-3 months (short-term) between March 1st 2024 - April 30th 2024
- 2 positions of Visiting Researchers: 4-9 months (long-term) between February 1st 2024 - August 31st 2024

SELECTION PROCESS:

- applications will be evaluated by a Committee within the Host-Faculty
- decisions will be communicated within 1 month (maximum) of the end of registrations, no later than: December 1st 2023



APPLICATION FILE:

- 1-page description of the candidate's teaching / research profile
- 1-page motivation letter (detailing interest in collaboration and benefits for the host institution)
- 2 courses structure/ 1 research structure - title, abstract, topics, objectives, methods, targeted results, selected bibliography (max. 4 pages)
- Letter of acceptance from the Host Faculty / Department (recommended)

CALENDAR:

- Application period: September 1st - November 1st 2023
- Evaluation of applications and possible interviews with shortlisted applicants: November 2023
- Notification of results: December 2023

Position 2 - Specialist in Migration studies, demonstrable international research experience, publications in indexed international journals in the field of migration, experience in organising international conferences, experience in qualitative methods research

DESCRIPTION OF THE VISITING LECTURER POSITION:

Position 1:

- Teaching and evaluating activities in courses and seminars of Migration, Unemployment and the labour force, Sociology of migration, Economic sociology, Sociology of Social Integration, Social Stratification and Mobility, study programmes for undergraduate level in Sociology and Human Resources

- Global migration and social issues - workshops for PhD students, Master's students and young specialists in Sociology/Human Resources.

Position 2:

- Teaching and evaluating activities in courses and seminars of Introduction in Sociology, Sociology of Deviance, Social Stratification and Mobility, study programmes for undergraduate level in Sociology and Human Resources

- Methodology of social policy planning - workshops for PhD students, Master's students and young specialists in Sociology/Human Resources.

DESCRIPTION OF THE VISITING RESEARCHER POSITION:

Position 1:

- Research activity in the field of Sociology of Health and Medicine focusing on the intersection between technology, health and digital ecosystems (social networks, blogs, websites and electronic devices) whereby actors build new communities based on communication, shared knowledge and experiences related to their disease or digital tools for careers and health professionals.

- Submission for publication of at least one article (Web of science/Scopus) or book chapter to an internationally recognized academic publisher and/or contribution to the submission of a Horizon Europe 2020 or equivalent application in collaboration with WUT colleagues.

- From social planning to design. New tools for social and health interventions - workshops for PhD students, Master's students and young specialists in Sociology/Human Resources.

Position 2:

Research in the field of: Migration

Objectives: to identify and analyse the process of inclusion at the local level by examining the institutions involved, communities, mechanisms for identifying racism.

The impact of the research results on the participating institutions:

-Publication of two articles in peer-reviewed journals.

-The organisation of a workshop

-The organisation of a conference
